

### **Saint Catherine's Terms and Conditions:**

By registering for Saint Catherine's Parachute Day, you are agreeing to the following:

All participants should satisfy themselves that they meet the requirements required by Skydive GB to take part before registering. If you have any doubts, please speak to your GP. Skydive GB Terms and Conditions can be accessed via the following link: [Terms & Conditions | Skydive GB](#)

Each participant is required to pay a deposit of £60 at the time of booking which secures your tandem Sky Dive place and is non-refundable, it is however, valid for twelve months from the date of booking and should you be unable to complete your jump due to inclement weather for example, alternative arrangements can be made via you and the airfield.

#### **There are two options for taking part in Parachute Day: Fundraising, or Self-Funded:**

If you select the '**Fundraising**' option, your £460 minimum sponsorship is made up of:

- £60 non-refundable registration fee which secures your place on the skydive.
- £189 remaining skydiving fees (\*\*must be received 1 week prior to skydive)
- £211 minimum sponsorship which goes directly to patient care.

This is a sponsored event. You are asked to please raise as much money as possible for Patient Care at Saint Catherine's and by signing up for the "Fundraising Option", **you are committing to raising a minimum of £400\* (not including your initial registration fee of £60)**

If you raise money via an online fundraising page such as JustGiving, all your sponsorship will come directly to our bank account. If you have only raised part of the amount required on your online page then you will still need to pay the outstanding balance. Money can be paid via card over the phone or by cash, which must be sent to Saint Catherine's so that it arrives one week before your jump. Alternatively, payments can be taken by credit/debit card over the phone 01723 378406.

If there is any money outstanding, you will be expected to pay the outstanding balance yourself, otherwise, you will have the option to book an alternative date in the future within twelve months of the original booking date. This is in place to protect Saint Catherine's against loss of patient funds.

**Please note that under Gift Aid law, If a sponsor is connected to the event participant (i.e. wife, husband, civil partner, brother, sister, parent, grandchild, the wife, husband or civil partner of a relative, a company under control of the donor or under control of the connected persons) they are unable to Gift Aid their donation as the fundraiser is receiving a benefit (part of the sponsorship will cover the cost of the skydive).**

If you have selected the '**Self-Funded**' option, your minimum sponsorship is made up of:

- £249 Skydive fee: £60 non-refundable registration fee which secures your place on the skydive, plus £189 payable to Skydive GB due one week prior to the jump date.
- £211 minimum sponsorship which goes directly to patient care.

Any further additional offline funds raised over the minimum required amount need to please arrive at Saint Catherine's two weeks after the Skydive or can be paid onto your online page by banking the money into your own account and then paying it onto the online page via your credit/debit card.

Please note matched funding from companies cannot be included in your minimum sponsorship – this is classed as additional sponsorship.

Participants must follow the instructions of the organisers Skydive GB or their appointed agents (including volunteers) at all times.

I acknowledge and accept that Saint Catherine's cannot at any time guarantee the weather, times of jumps, or jump orders. I further acknowledge and accept that as an activity which is subject to the weather limitations, Participants must not be under the influence of alcohol or any other harmful substances.

Photographs may be taken at all events to be used in future publicity, both printed and digital including social media. If you do not want to be included in these photos, please speak to a member of staff or volunteer and please do not pose for any photographs.

Saint Catherine's will take reasonable care to ensure that the event is conducted in a safe manner. Liability cannot be accepted for any damage, injury or loss arising from the negligence of participants (whether through failure to observe the rules of the event or otherwise).

### **Medical Restrictions**

For a tandem skydive you must be at least 16 years old, there is no maximum age for tandem skydiving. Those between the ages of 16-18 will require a parent or guardian present to sign a permission form.

All skydivers should be in good health and possess a reasonable basic level of fitness and must weigh under 15 stone (95.25kg) with your weight in proportion to your height. Certain conditions preclude participants from taking part.

You will be required to sign a medical form before your jump declaring your fitness to take part - this will be sent to you upon receipt of your expression of interest to check eligibility. If you are in any doubt, please contact the airfield for further information on 01262 228033. Those under the age of 18 will need the medical form signed by a parent or guardian; if you answer yes to any of the health issues on the 115a <https://dashboard.skydivegb.com/self-declaration-of-fitness-115a> medical form, you will need form 115b <https://skydivegb.com/images/forms/Form-115B-Student-Tandem-Doctors-Certificate.pdf> signed by their doctor prior to your jump and to bring this along with you on the day of your jump. Failure to fulfil these conditions will result in the place on the jump being forfeited.

Skydive GB Instructors will make all final decisions on if a health condition might make it dangerous for an individual to take part in a dive and refuse their admission. In this instance, money paid will be forfeited and Saint Catherine's Hospice will not be responsible for any costs, however we will make every reasonable effort to reschedule the jump with prior notice and proof of medical exemption from a GP.

### **Insurance**

On payment to the Airfield of the fee for the training and the jump, all jumpers are covered by the British Parachute Association Liability Insurance Policy up to £10 million for liability to Third Parties. Please note that this does not cover you or your dependents for personal injury including death. You are therefore strongly recommended to take out your own insurance cover for personal accident benefits to whatever level you consider appropriate. You can do this either in conjunction with your own insurance broker or if in any doubt you should seek independent advice.

**IMPORTANT NOTICE** - Parachuting is an adventure sport and participation in such sports necessarily involves a risk of injury or death regardless of the standard of training, supervision and equipment employed. I voluntarily accept all the risks inherent in the sport and I agree for myself and my personal representatives to indemnify and hold harmless Saint Catherine's and Skydive GB against any claim or claims whether on my own account or from third parties arising out of any accident or incident resulting in any loss or damage (including bodily injury and death).
